CELEBRATING BIRTHDAYS....(in the Church calendar). The Liturgical calendar normally celebrates a saint on their day of death (their entry into eternal life). Only three birthdays are celebrated: obviously our Lord on December 25, John the Baptist on June 24 and the Blessed Virgin Mary on September 8.

Here I wish to focus on Our Lord and John the Baptist. The church does not know each date for certain but establishes the dates for symbolic, poetic or theological reasons. Both the births of Jesus and John are celebrated immediate-



ly after a solstice: December 25 after the winter solstice of December 21 and June 24 very soon after the summer solstice of June 21.

To make sense of the rest of this, please remember the famous line from John the Baptist: "He (Jesus) must increase and I must decrease." By June 24, the amount of light in the northern hemisphere is beginning to decrease each day as the sun "goes south" for the winter. By December 25, the sun begins to return and light increases day by

Two final thoughts: it often takes much faith either way as we experience the cold of winter or the heat of summer to believe the sun is moving as it were. But time will prove right what we know from experiencing each year. And, more importantly, as the liturgical calendar is trying to remind us: let us do our best to decrease our ego that Christ may increase in us as summer moves on. Father Kerry


ISOLATED CATHOLICS




